Getting Started

First, to officially become the GOLD officer in your Section, you need to update your name and names of the GOLD ExCom members on IEEE vTo ols system. Please inform us when it is done.

Develop Website

We will update the R8 GOLD Webpage with your contact. If you have a website of your Affinity Group, please send us the link so that we can add it too. If not, we strongly advise you to have one soon, it is very important for your local communication and gives more visibility to your Affinity Group inside your section and also within IEEE at large.

When you organize any event, please let us (r8gold@ieee.org) know, your section and (most importantly!) report it to IEEE via the L31 form. For your information: GOLD AGs must submit at least two L31 reports per year to be considered as an active GOLD AG.

e-Membership

For Students and Graduate Students:

Individuals who are studying at an accredited institution, are eligible to take IEEE student membership. Student Membership fee for the full calendar year is \$27. New members joining from 1 March till 15 August pay \$13,50 (half-year dues) for their membership till the end of the calendar year E-membership is not applicable for students and graduate students. IEEE membership rates are already discounted for students, and in fact are less than e-Membership rates. After graduation students are automatically upgraded to the Member Grade and pay 50% for the first year.

For New and Renewing Professional:

Full year Membership fee for professionals is \$152. Half year fee (1 March till 15August) is \$76 for new members only.

IEEE offers an e-Membership option to new and renewing members who reside in developing countries. Full year e-Membership fee for Region 8 is \$63 and for half year (1 March till 15 August) \$31,50 (for new members only).

IEEE e-Membership provides all of the existing IEEE Membership benefits but no paper delivery of publications and membership materials. Societies decide about their membership dues and the types of membership options.

There are also Special Circumstances for reduced membership dues.
